Montana out-scored Idaho 27-6 in the final half and 13-0 in the fourth quarter, but the Griz rally fell short. Hisaw was 15-of-23-0 for 310 yards and 6 TDs, three of his scoring passes going to Robert Scott (6 catches for 120) yards, and two others to Dwight McKinzie (5 for 111).

Griz quarterback Dave Dickenson set single-game records: completing 43-of-72 passes for 558 yards. He passed for 5 scores and had 2 interceptions in the game. Mike Erhardt had a career-high 10 catches for 222 yards and 2 scores, while Raul Pacheco had 6 grabs for 41 yards and 2 TDs. UM rushed for only 29 yards in the game (UI had 109).

Idaho QB Eric Hisaw tied a UI record with six touchdown passes. He also ran for a TD during a day during which he led Idaho in rushing (15 carries for 76 yards) and passing (15-of-23 for 310 yards).

WINNING SEASONS: 14 IN A ROW.

UM's win over EWU two weeks ago give the Griz their 14th straight winning season — a skein that started in 1986.

HOME COOKIN': Montana is 80-10 (.888) in Washington-Grizzly Stadium since its first game there in mid-1986 and 42-2 (.955) over the past five-plus seasons.

GRIZ COACH DENNEHY: Mick Dennehy is now in his fourth season as the head coach at his alma mater (1973) and his ninth overall at UM (he was UM's O-coordinator from 1991 to 1995).

At Montana, Mick is 38-10 (.792) overall and he's 26-5 (.839) in Big Sky games. He is 0-0 vs. Idaho as a head coach. Dennehy is 48-23 overall (.676) in his seventh season at the college level.

UI Coach Tormey: Chris Tormey begins his fifth season at Idaho, where he has compiled a 32-22 record. His is a 1978 graduate of the University of Idaho. He was a first-team all-Big Sky Conference selection at defensive end as a junior and a

The Griz vs. Idaho

THE SERIES: The Griz trail in the series 54-23-2. The Vandals have won 14 of the last 21, but the Griz have won 4 of the last 5. Montana is 3-2 in Washington-Grizzly Stadium versus Idaho. The Griz won in 1988 (26-17); 1992 (47-29); and 1994 (45-21), while UI won in 1986 (38-31) and 1990 (35-14). The teams first played in 1903, UI winning 28-0 in Moscow.

LAST MEETING: The teams last met Oct. 21, 1995, the Vandals winning 55-43 in Moscow. Montana won its next 7 straight games en route to the Division I-AA national championship. Idaho took a huge 49-16 lead at halftime, as quarterback Eric Hisaw threw 5 touchdown passes. (UM's other loss that year was 38-21 at Washington State). This was Idaho's last season in the Big Sky, as they joined the Big West Conference in 1996.
